The Roman Catholic Church now offers low gluten hosts for gluten free parishioners so they will not have to worry about getting ill or only receiving the consecrated Blood of Jesus.

These hosts are produced in strict adherence to Canon Law and only contain .002 percent gluten. Please note these hosts are not gluten free but the small amount they contain does not bother most people with gluten allergies.

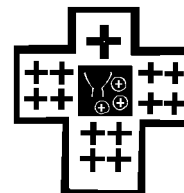
