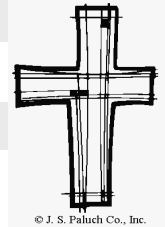

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The Holy Father usually marks the solemn opening of the Lenten fast with a procession and Mass on Ash Wednesday evening. He walks from the Benedictine monastery, San Anselmo, down the Aventine hill to the Dominican monastery of Santa Sabina. This very old tradition was revived by Pope John XXIII in the late 1950s. Have you ever wondered who gives the pope his ashes? It's the cardinal who has been given the "title" of the church of Santa Sabina. The pope's homily at this Mass states his theme for Lent. Santa Sabina dates from the fifth century, and is one of the most beautiful churches in Rome. One of the panels on its main doors features the Crucifixion, a scene not normally depicted in art until much later. In the year 1219 the pope gave the church to Saint Dominic for his new religious order, the "Order of Preachers," commonly called the Dominicans, and it remains their world headquarters to this day. That pope, Honorius III, was a member of the Savelli family, and this church was their personal family chapel. Sabina was a wealthy Roman lady who became a Christian and was martyred, and whose home became a place of prayer. Later, the church built on that spot was dedicated to her memory.

Prayer Starters for All the Days of Lent by Tom McGrath

Perhaps recently you've felt an inner prompting to tend more to your spiritual life. Perhaps you've even promised yourself that "some day soon" you would get serious and act on that desire. Let this Lent be your opportunity to make good on that promise and to take advantage of God's promise, "I will be with you always." Whether you begin this journey on Ash Wednesday or another day, for the next 40 days you have the chance to give some time over to spiritual growth. Here is an outline that can help you focus on a different virtue or spiritual practice each day.

Pray today for: (Prayers #9 through 40 to be continued . . .)

- 1. Emptiness.** We begin Lent by fasting so that we can make room for that which we truly yearn for. Pray that your physical hunger will give way to your spiritual longing.
- 2. A return to God.** Like the father of the prodigal son, God stands waiting for our return. Today, pray, "Help me return to you with all my heart."
- 3. Acceptance.** When life's burdens and irritations arrive, pray for the gift of acceptance and live with grace.
- 4. An open heart and mind.** We all have attitudes and prejudices that could bear changing. Tell God you are willing to learn new lessons and see deeper truths.
- 5. Charity.** Donate money or food to a charity you believe in. Involve your family or friends and you will also be building community.
- 6. Healing.** Many times old wounds inside stifle our spiritual growth. Express willingness to open those wounds to God's healing power.
- 7. Forgiveness.** Ask God's pardon for all the ways you may have strayed during the past year. Say a prayer expressing your sorrow for your sins.
- 8. Faithfulness.** Sometimes our good intentions get sidetracked, or we grow weary of doing what we ought to do. Pray today that you can remain faithful to your commitments to God, to those around you, and to yourself.
